A crane permit is required for high-reach construction equipment operating within 6km of London Heliport above 10m in height, or higher than other surrounding obstacles.

Important Advice for cranes in the immediate vicinity (within 2 km) of London Heliport

Inform London Heliport urgently in case of:

- Failure to provide obstruction lighting installation before darkness on date of erection
- Failure of lighting (pending repair) once crane erected and operational which may render crane unlit after dark
- Any other change in details of crane plan (e.g. erection date, operating radius, height of crane structure)
